Concrete Laborer

The position may operate a variety of hand and power tools, clean up rubble and debris, remove waste materials and may clean and prepare sites, set concrete forms, and pour concrete. The position will assist other craft workers.

Essential Functions

- Perform minimal carpentry and concrete finishing tasks.
- Set string line, set forms, and grade.

- Operate jackhammers, brush clippers, mowers, and other small equipment and tools to maintain the job site.
- Physically lift up to 50 lbs.
- Operate skid loader and/or backhoes.
- Maintains a clean job site, pick up and clean all tools and equipment, and secures job site each day to eliminate potential hazards.
- Performs materials handling and storage.
- Follows daily procedures and protocols as set forth in job orientations and training.
- Daily reporting of time, progress and materials used thru electronic reporting, as assigned.
- Maintain and protect all property in excellent condition.
- Perform any other tasks assigned to support and improve the overall team operations.
- Perform routine inspection on assigned equipment and refer defects or repairs to supervisor, clean equipment.
- Properly follows all state and federal agencies safety procedures.
- Promotes and complies with all company safety policies and procedures; brings problems to the attention of the foreman, project manager, safety director, or HR director.
- Maintain certifications required by all state and federal agencies and company safety programs.
- Maintain a professional attitude with owners, inspectors, public and company personal.
